CPRG Program Basics



1. Planning grants to develop strong climate pollution reduction strategies (\$250 million)

- Administered through non-competitive grants in 2023

2. Competitive implementation grants to help put plans into action (\$4.6 billion)

- Selections announced summer 2024; awards by EOY

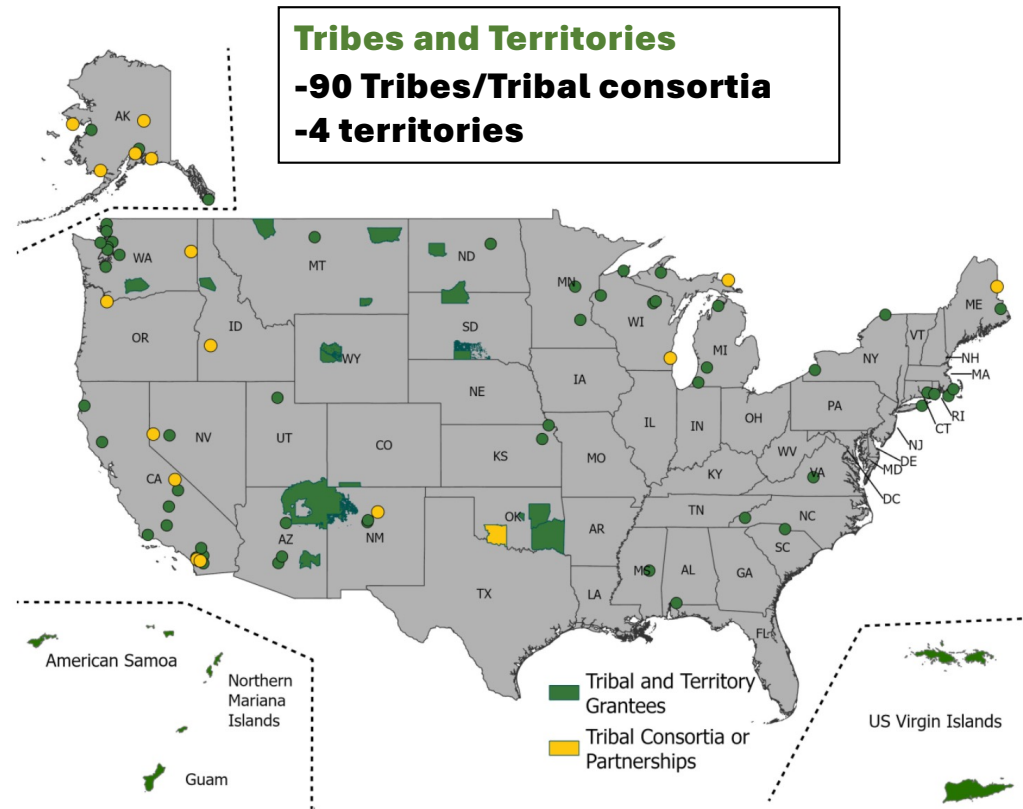
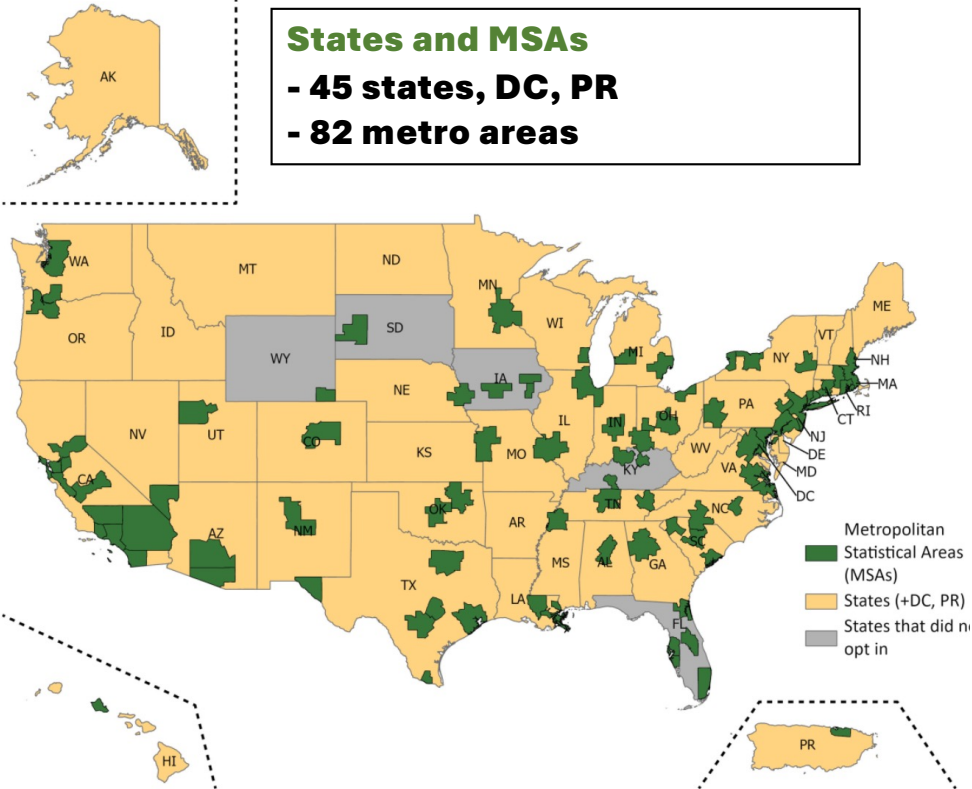
CPRG Planning Grantees

States and MSAs

- 45 states, DC, PR
- 82 metro areas

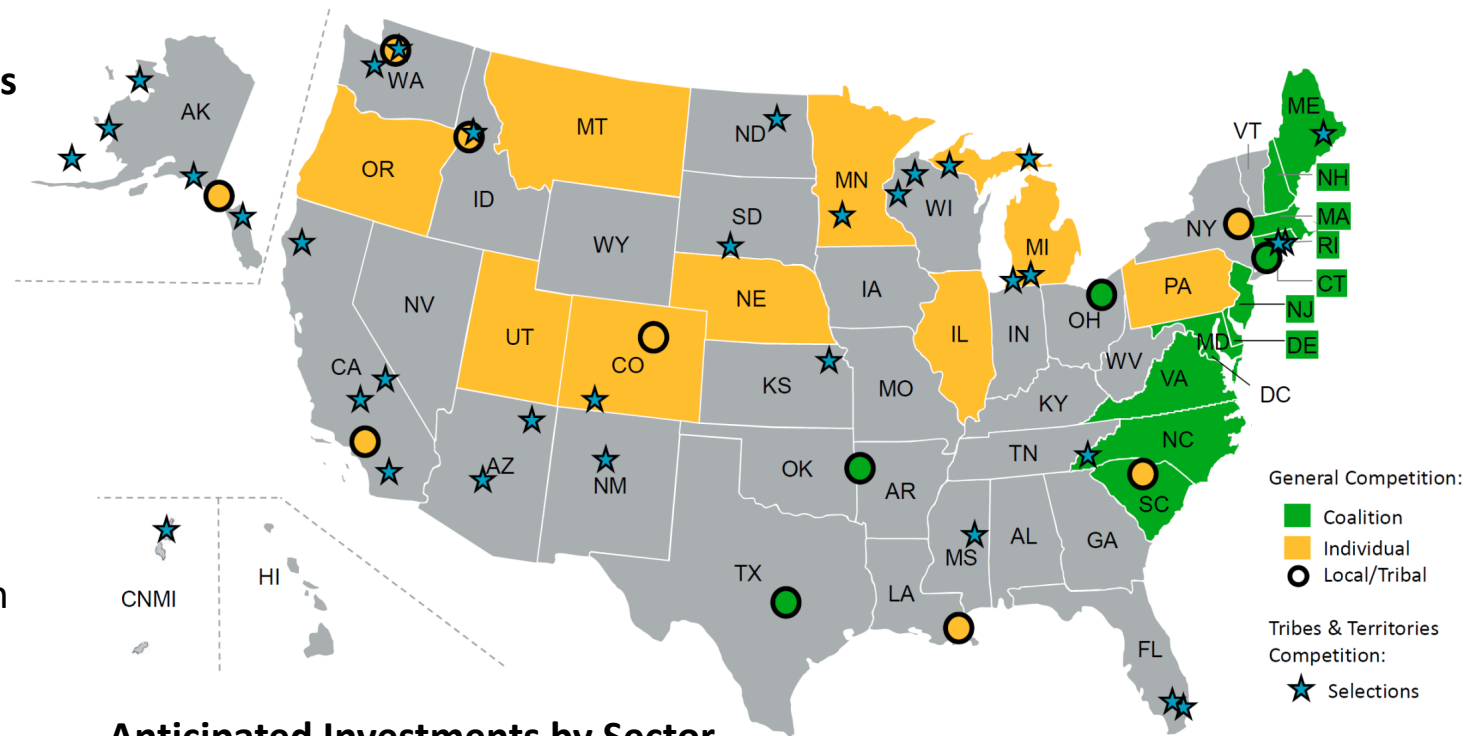
Tribes and Territories

- 90 Tribes/Tribal consortia
- 4 territories



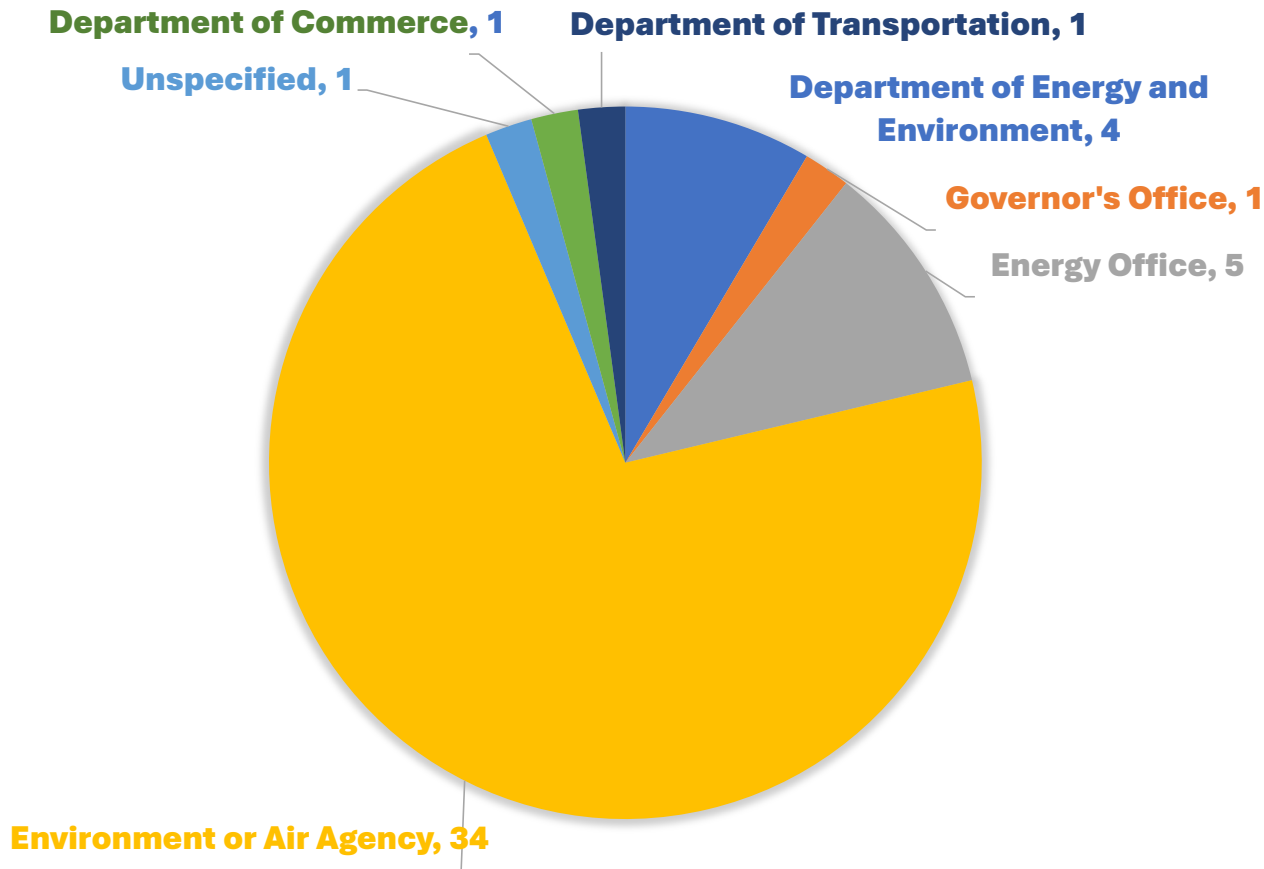
EPA recently selected 59 applications for award

- **General Competition (States and MSAs):** \$33 billion in requests across ~300 applications for \$4.3 billion in available funds; 25 selectees.
- **Tribes and Territories Competition:** \$1.4 billion in requests across 110 applications for \$300 million in available funds; 34 selectees

Interagency and Intergovernmental Coordination
