## Grain Belt Express community grant program

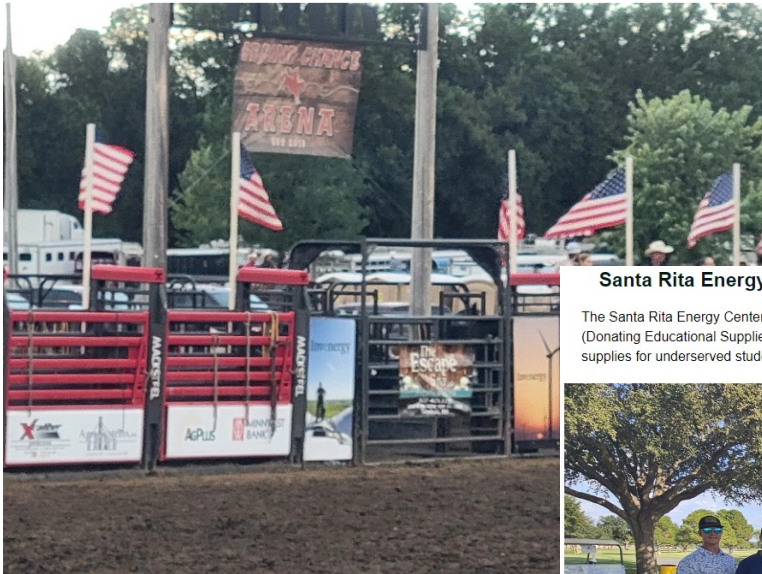
